Welcome

Today, surrounded by a fast-paced world, Rocheport is an oasis of tranquility located in central Missouri, an easy two-hour drive from Kansas City or St. Louis. Rocheport boasts splendid dining, sophisticated shopping and world-class accommodations. A winegarden high atop the bluffs offers an inspiring view of the the river valley. The Rocheport Museum provides glimpses of our colorful past which dates to Lewis and Clark's 1804 "Voyage of Discovery" and includes steamboat days, 1840 site of the Whig Convention, Civil War battles and skirmishes, and the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railroad, built in 1892-1893.

Founded in 1825, Rocheport is located 12 miles west of Columbia, only two miles off I-70 at Missouri River mile marker 186.4 and the scenic gateway Katy Trail mile marker 178.3. Celebrating the 20th anniversary since it's opening in 1990, the Katy Trail at Rocheport became the first segment of the 238 mile trail that spans the state of Missouri. The Katy Trail is America's longest rails-to-trails project. Bike rentals, refreshments, water, restrooms, parking and quaint shops are all available at the trailhead.

Walk quiet streets & savor the relaxed movement of time.

Explore the rich history, enjoy the towering bluffs along the Katy Trail and be sure to leave time to sit on a bench and just watch the Mighty Mo go by.
